### Day 1 Saturday, June 20

**Minneapolis/St. Paul—Oslo:** Depart Mpls/St. Paul on your Icelandair flight at 7:20pm or request space from your home city upon registration.

### Day 2 Sunday, June 21 [D]

**Oslo—Lillehammer:** Arrive Gardermoen Airport Oslo. Drive to Lillehammer, nestled by the shores of Norway's largest lake, Lake Mjøsa. Stop at Ringsaker Church for reception and tour of the church. Proceed to Lillehammer, nestled along the shores of Norway's largest lake, Lake Mjøsa. Dinner and overnight at Radisson SAS Lillehammer.

### Day 3 Monday, June 22 [B,D]

**Lillehammer:** Breakfast. Transfer to Maihaugen. Day's seminar with lectures on the following topics: History of Gudbrandsdal 18th & 19th century; History of Maihaugen; Gudbrandsdal buildings at Maihaugen Part I and Gudbrandsdal buildings at Maihaugen Part II. Reception and evening banquet at Maihaugen. Return to hotel for overnight.

### Day 4 Tuesday, June 23 [B,L,D]

**Lillehammer:** Breakfast. Transfer to Maihaugen. Morning tour of Maihaugen including a behind the scenes tour. Opportunity to use library and archives. Lunch at Maihaugen following by Gudbrandsdal Historielag greeting and information. Publications & meeting with Norwegians. Afternoon coffee and closing. Celebrate Mid-Summer evening at Maihaugen with entertainment, exhibitions and a bonfire. Return to hotel for overnight.

### Day 5 Wednesday, June 24 [B,D]

**Lillehammer—Øyer—Tretten:** Breakfast. View the site of the 1994 Winter Olympics. Visit Hafjell Alpine Center, Øyer, an alpine destination that was developed for the 1994 Winter Olympics. View the hundreds of high-cost cabins which have been built on the slopes above Øyer, following the Olympics and learn about the importance of tourism and sports. Proceed to Tretten. Visit a modern Norwegian dairy farm, followed by a tour of Tine Dairy Factory. This factory, is one of five dairy companies owned by 16,312 dairy farmers which produces, distributes and exports dairy products. Dinner and overnight at Glomstad Gård.

### Day 6 Thursday, June 25 [B,L,D]

**Excursion to Gausdal/Espedal:** Breakfast. Drive to Gausdal. Crossing the Segalstad Bridge we arrive in the agricultural district of East Gausdal. Travel the Peer Gynt Road. The legendary Per Gynt is said to have roamed this area and inspired the poet and dramatist Henrik Ibsen to write his famous play, Peer Gynt. At Ruten we reach an altitude of 5000 ft. and enjoy views of the Jotunheimen and Rondane mountain ranges. At Auggedal, visit the Ulsrud Farm from the late 18th century. Continue to Espedalen. Drive south through the Espedal Valley with its rich flora and fauna and beautiful lakes. See the Espedalen Church with its unusual graveyard. During the 17th century there were copper works in the valley and from 1846 to 1878 nickel was also mined. Picnic lunch (fish soup & flatbread) at Helvete (Hell) Nature Park, with some of the largest potholes in Northern Europe, many of them more than 160 ft deep and 65 ft wide. Learn about the clairvoyant, Knut Rasmussen Nordgaarden ("Wise Knut", 1782-1876), who resided in this area and who was famous throughout the country for his healing powers and his ability to find the lost. Return to Tretten for dinner and overnight.

### Day 7 Friday, June 26 [B,D]

**Tretten—Sør Fron—Kvitfjell:** Breakfast. Guided tour of Dale-Gudbrands Gard, Hundorp, with its ancient grave mounds. Visit the Sør-Fron Church, referred to as the Cathedral of Gudbrandsdal. Tour the areas of Harpefoss, Kvarvet and Venabygd Mountain area. Lunch on own. Proceed to GudbrandsGard Hotell, Kvitfjell, our home for the next three nights. The hotel, at an altitude of 2443 ft., is situated close to the middle station on the Olympic Downhill Arena at Kvitfjell, one of the most varied and challenging alpine arenas in Europe. Tour the Kvitfjell Olympic Alpine Downhill Arena and development area. Banquet at the hotel with folklore and local entertainment.

### Day 8 Saturday, June 27 [B,D]

**Excursion to Ringebu:** Breakfast. Guided tour of Harpefoss-Kvarvet-Venabygdsfjell including Venabygd Church. At Fron visit DaleGudbrandsgard. Proceed to Ringebu for participation in Ringebu Days (shopping, displays, bunad parade, folk dancing, sports). Coffee at Vestad Farm. Return to hotel for dinner and overnight.

### Day 9 Sunday, June 28 [B,D]

**Excursion to Venabygd & Ringebu:** Breakfast. Proceed to Ringebu. Following a visit to the wood carving center, Gildesvollen, tour the Ringebu Stave Church. After a church service in English enjoy church coffee and a guided tour of the Weidemann Art Collection and Exhibition. Mountain excursion prior to evening concert at Ringebu Stave Church with the Heidal fiddlers and dancers. Return to GudbrandsGard for overnight.

Explore the back roads of Norway. Tour some of Norway's most historic sites, buildings and museums. Enjoy the breathtaking natural beauty of the Jotenheimen and Rondane Mountain ranges, the untamed Sjoa River and Norway's largest lake, Lake Mjøsa. A series of special events and visits are planned including a seminar at Maihaugen, celebration of Mid-summer, and Ringebu Days!

### Day 10 Monday, June 29 [B,L,D]

**Kvitfjell—Bøverdal:** Breakfast. Drive to Kvam. Visit the Forestia Fiberboard Factory. A stop at the Gudbrandsdal War Museum offers an insight into the events which took place in Gudbrandsdal during WWII. War Museum. See the English War Memorial at Kvam Church. View Sinclair's grave commemorating George Sinclair, the leader of the Scottish mercenaries who were on their way to Sweden in 1612 to assist the Swedes in their war against Denmark/Norway. The Scots were stopped at the Battle of Kringen and George Sinclair fell. Proceed to Sjoa. We see the Rafting Center and we follow the wild Sjoa River famous for white-water rafting, to Heidal. Tour and lunch at Nordre Ekre farm. In Heidal tour the Brown Cheese Factory and the local Handicrafts store. Visit Nisselofet with its collection of gnomes, goblins and trolls. Cross the mountain pass to Randsverk and on to Bøverdalen. Dinner and overnight at Elveseter.

### Day 11 Tuesday, June 30 [B,D]

**Excursion in area:** Breakfast. Drive to Skjåk and Uppigard Skjåk, a typical farm complex in Gudbrandsdal with its famous woodcarvings. In Lom tour the Lom Stave Church. Lunch on own. Stop at the Fosshiem Stone Center. Opportunity to explore the Stone Museum and shop in the jewelry gallery. Enjoy a guided visit of the Jorgine Boomer home and museum with coffee and "rumbrod." Boomer went to New York early in the century and married the owner of the Waldorf Astoria. Return to Elveseter for dinner and overnight.

### Day 12 Wednesday, July 1 [B,D]

**Bøverdal—Vågåmo:** Breakfast. From Lom drive to Vågå on the western side of lake Vågåvatnet. Visit a sheep and goat farm in Øvre Nordhørrad followed by a tour of a farm which produces "mandel" (almond) potatoes. Dinner and overnight at Vågå Hotel.

### Day 13 Thursday, July 2 [B,L,D]

**Vågåmo—Dombås:** Breakfast. Morning visit to Lesja Church, richly decorated with carved tableaux depicting Bible stories. Opportunity to visit Lesja Bygdetun, an open-air museum with a collection of 11 houses which illustrates architecture, way of life and conditions in olden times. Proceed to Dovregubbens Hall. Lunch. Afternoon visit to Budsjord, a protected farm from the 17th / 18th centuries. One of the 17 buildings is believed to date back to the 1400's when this was a farm belonging to the bishop. In the Dovre area, visit the Hjerleidske Woodcraft Center tour the Dovre Church, a cross-shaped church built in 1736 from hand-shaped jointed timbers, and Eystein Church, Dovrefjell. Dinner and overnight at Dombås Hotel. Lecture by John Olson, The Reindeer's Realm.

### Day 14 Friday, July 3 [B,D]

**Dombås—Otta:** Breakfast. At Nord Sel Church we find a memorial and the graves of British soldiers who fell in this area in 1940. Arrive at Jørundgård, a reconstructed medieval farm, setting of the main work of Nobel prize winner Sigrid Undset's Kristin Lavransdatter. The trilogy, now translated into more than 70 languages is the most widely-read novel of the 20th century. The distinctive and complicated geology of Sel district provides unique resources of stone and ore. Local factories produce soapstone (used for ovens and fireplaces, as well as the production of high-quality ornaments) and Otta Slate (used for flooring, wall tiles, steps, as well as decoratively) is well-known far beyond Norway's boundaries and represents North Gudbrandsdalen's oldest industry. Dinner and overnight at Rondeslottet Hotel affording a beautiful view of the Rondane Mountains. Rondane National Park is the oldest national park in Norway, established on 21 December 1962. The park contains ten peaks above 2,000 meters (6,560 ft), with the highest being Rondeslottet at an altitude of 2,178 m (7,146 ft). The park is an important habitat for herds of wild reindeer.

### Day 15 Saturday, July 4 [B,L]

**Otta—Hamar—Oslo:** Breakfast. As we drive south of Otta, we see the Kringen Monument and learn about the Battle of Kringen. Proceed to Hamar where we visit the Emigrant Museum and view the church that was moved from Houston, MN. Lunch. Proceed to Oslo. Overnight at Grand Hotel. Balance of day and evening on own.

### Day 16 Sunday, July 5 [B,D]

**Oslo:** Breakfast. Morning free. Three-hour afternoon sightseeing tour of Oslo with local guide includes Vigeland Park and the Viking Ship Museum. Afternoon free. Farewell dinner and overnight at Grand Hotel Oslo.

### Day 17 Monday, July 6 [B]

**Oslo—USA:** Transfer to Oslo Gardermoen Airport. Depart Oslo at 2:45pm on Icelandair. Arrive Minneapolis/St. Paul 5:55pm. Longer stays may be requested at registration for an additional charge of \$50 per person.

# TERMS & CONDITIONS—PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

## RESERVATIONS & PAYMENT

To make reservations, complete application form and send deposit of \$500 per person to address shown on application form or register at [www.BrekkeTours.com](http://www.BrekkeTours.com). The final balance is due 90 days prior to departure. Early departures and/or extended stays are subject to availability, must be requested upon registration, and entail a surcharge of \$50, plus weekend surcharge of \$25 per direction, if applicable. For reservations or final payment made within 21 days prior to departure, there is a \$25 per reservation handling/express fee. Checks, Money Orders, VISA and MasterCard are accepted as forms of payment. In case of billing error, we reserve the right to re-invoice with correct pricing.

## TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

It is the responsibility of each passenger to obtain proper travel documents, such as passport and visa. Each passenger must be in possession of a passport with a validity of at least six (6) months beyond the conclusion of their trip. A visa is not required for Scandinavia or Western Europe for stays of less than 3 months. A visa is required for passengers traveling to Russia.

**It is imperative that your airline ticket matches your first and last name exactly as it reads on your passport.** Any changes to your air booking, which include spelling, are subject to a change fee, penalties, or cancellation.

With full payment, tour documents are normally sent 14-21 days prior to departure and should arrive within 6 business days. If you request documents earlier, and if it is possible to accommodate you, there is a \$25 per reservation handling/ express fee.

## CANCELLATIONS

The following per person cancellation fee applies: More than 90 days prior to departure: \$250; 90-45 days: \$500; 44-7 days: \$2000; less than 7 days: nonrefundable. Cancellation fees may also apply to any additional services, including accommodations, independently supplied services, and optional excursions reserved prior to, during and after the tour. Cancellations must be in writing. Inquire about a different cancellation policy for "Norwegian Coastal Voyage Experience" or Brekke Tours promotions to other destinations. A change of itinerary or traveler name (substitution) after receipt of deposit will be treated as a cancellation and new reservation; standard cancellation fees apply. ## LUGGAGE

Please be advised that not all hotels in Scandinavia are air-conditioned.
